

Imagination Theater Participation Agreement

Mission Statement. Participant agrees to follow the mission statement of Imagination Theater at all times. The mission statement is:

“To tell good stories well in an atmosphere of respect, trust, challenge, and personal growth.”

1. Rehearsals. By accepting a role in this production, participant accepts and understands the importance of maximum participation in, and attendance at, all rehearsals. Participant agrees to make every effort to arrive prior to the scheduled start time of rehearsals and to avoid circumstances causing the participant to need to leave rehearsals early. Participant agrees to coordinate with the director or producer in advance when possible should unforeseen circumstances necessitate the missing of rehearsals or late arrival at rehearsals. Participant understands that repeated late arrival or missing of rehearsals may result in the participant being removed from the production at the sole discretion of the director.

2. Schedule Conflicts. Participants accepting roles in the production may not miss any scheduled performances. Participants accepting roles in the production agree to review the production schedule prior to accepting a role and determine the following:

- The participant will not miss more than 3 rehearsals during the rehearsal period.
- **The participant will not miss any rehearsals in the 2 weeks prior to the opening performance of the production.**

List Schedule Conflicts:

3. Students. Elementary, middle, and high school student participants understand that participation in this production is based upon their satisfactory performance in their required schoolwork as determined by their parents and the production director. Students will be expected to work on school assignments during rehearsals when they are present but not actually required to be rehearsing.

4. Learning of Lines and Lyrics. All participants agree to make every effort to quickly and fully learn their lines and vocal lyrics and be “Off-Book” by the required dates.

5. Ensemble. All participants must recognize that this production is intended as an “ensemble effort,” requiring each participant to extend respect, courtesy, and encouragement to all other participants at all times. Inappropriate language and extremes of behavior will not be tolerated.

6. Environment and Safety. It is Imagination Theater’s policy to provide an environment free of safety hazards and any forms of harassment. Participants, and their family members, are encouraged to assist in this effort by immediately bringing any problems to the attention of the Production Director and the IT Artistic Director.

7. Photo Release. Participants authorize their photograph or video image to be used in connection with publicity for this production.

8. Participation Fee. There are no audition or participation fees at Imagination Theater.

9. IT! Code of Conduct. If cast, participants agree to follow the code of conduct as posted and published on the website.
